





A word from Fr. Bill.....

Dear Parishioners:

Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia!

It has been a long time (almost 6 weeks) since we have been able to say that word at Mass. It feels liberating to be able to do so. Lent is a time of self-reflection, naming our sins, and resolving to respond better to God's invitation to share in God's life. At Easter, we say we believe in God, that we reject sin, the glamour of evil and refuse to be mastered by sin. Alleluia!

At the Easter Vigil, we move from darkness to light. We light the fire outside and from it we light the Paschal Candle (which will be lit at every baptism and funeral in the next year) and from the Paschal Candle each person has his/her candle lit from another parishioner and process illuminating the church. We move from darkness to light and hopefully bring that light to others each day. What a gift! Alleluia!

At Easter, we bless the Easter water. It is this water by which we will be sprinkled when we renew our baptismal vows. It is this water which reminds us we have been washed clean in Christ. It is this water that will be placed in the Holy Water fonts (for the first time since the pandemic began) to remind us each time we bless ourselves with it as we come into church that this is where the baptized gather. Alleluia!

Most importantly, we celebrate that Jesus died and rose from the dead so that we can live forever. He destroyed our death and restored our life. He has made it possible for us to live forever in total peace and joy and happiness. Alleluia!

There has been a great deal of darkness in our lives during the past year: the pandemic and all its ramifications, the attack on the Capital building, the children at the borders, the killings in Atlanta and Boulder and the streets of our cities, the continued killing of the unborn and those convicted of crimes. We can all add our own darknesses to the list. We must look at what we celebrate this day to bring light. Jesus said he would be with us all our days, in all situations and in all circumstances. In the midst of darkness, we need to bring the light of the Risen Jesus into our world. He has called us to dim the darkness and bring the light. Alleluia!

In our lives, let us joyfully proclaim the Mystery of faith: Christ has died. Christ is risen! Christ will come again. By your death and resurrection, Lord, you have redeemed the world. We proclaim your death, O Lord, and profess your resurrection until you come again. Save us, Savior of the world, for by your cross and resurrection you have set us free. Alleluia!

Yes, there is darkness, but, yes, the Risen Jesus is with us to bring light and has anointed us to bring that light to others. Alleluia!

St. Augustine says we are, "an Easter people and Alleluia is our song."

Have a wonderful Easter. Alleluia!
