

### A word from Fr. Bill....

#### Dear Parishioners:

Happy Holy Week. As you know, with today's celebration of Passion Sunday, we enter into the most solemn days of our Church year. This week we will celebrate the basic mysteries of our faith: the gift of the Eucharist, the gift of the Priesthood, the example of service in the Washing of the Feet, the suffering and death of Jesus on the cross and most importantly, the Resurrection of Jesus, which gives all of us the opportunity of eternal life. On Friday evening (7:30 PM), we will have a prayer service entitled, "The Seven Last Words," where parishioners will share a reflection on each on the last things Jesus said as he was on the Cross. On Saturday evening (7:30 PM), we will welcome Karen Connolly into our faith community as she will be baptized, receive Confirmation and First Communion at the Easter Vigil.

You will find an insert within this bulletin with the schedule of our Holy Week liturgies. I encourage everyone to participate in as many of them as possible.

About 80 students, Augustinian Friars, and teachers from ten Augustinian high schools in North America visited our parish on Saturday, April 8th. They were participating in the St. Augustine Value Institute (SAVI). What is that? For one weekend every year, students, faculty, staff, and board members of Augustinian high schools from North America meet at a hosting Augustinian school. This year St. Augustine Prep in Vineland, NJ was the host. Over the weekend, attendees (mostly students) share a common bond and Augustinian heritage. Presentations are given on Augustinian values (Veritas-truth, Caitas-charity, and Unitas-unity) and how they can be implemented in the classroom, while discussions and reflections are also held as well as prayer and socializing (they went to a Phillies game when they left here). Attendees came to the weekend this year from ten different Augustinian high schools in six states in this country and one school in Canada. They leave the event as one bonded in the common values and mission of St. Augustine. The schools which were represented this year were St. Rita's in Chicago IL, Austin Prep in Reading, MA, St. Augustine in Vineland, NJ, Malvern Prep in Malvern, PA, St. Augustine in San Diego, CA, Providence Catholic High School in New Lenox, IL, Cascia Hall in Tulsa, OK, Austin Catholic High School in Chesterfield, MI, Villanova Prep in Ojai, CA and Villanova College in King City, Canada. It was a great opportunity for all these students and teachers to see the first place the Augustinians came to in North America. They appreciated (at least I hope they did) seeing that they all have a common root, us, St. Augustine Parish in Philadelphia. You will find a picture of the SAVI group on the blog and photos link on our website.

This past week we received a "Certificate of Appreciation" from the Augustinian Sister Servants of Jesus and Mary in Tagaytay City in the Philippines. They received many gifts which you donated from the "Giving Tree" last Advent. Some of those things included disposable diapers, vitamins, aspirin, cough syrup, and baby formula, etc. Evidently these things are not that readily available in the Philippines. I join them in thanking you. We never know how much our generosity is needed and appreciated.

#### Dear Parishioners:

It is with a very heavy heart and great sadness that I tell you that I recently was advised by my Provincial that someone has made an accusation that I sexually abused a minor in the 1980s. I can tell you with 100% surety that there is no foundation whatsoever for such a charge against me. The Church, however, due to the climate of these days, has to do an investigation. I have agreed to voluntarily step aside as Pastor here until an investigation is completed. There is no certitude of how long that will take. In the meantime, please pray for me, pray for the accuser, pray for those doing the investigation and pray for the Church in these very trying days.
