



## A word from Fr. Bill.....

#### Dear Parishioners:

Last May, I explained to you how important the Parish Pastoral Council is to me. I rely on the Council members (9 parishioners-3 year terms-and 2 staff members) for advice on the pastoral needs of the parish. I take the opportunity to inform them of different things going on in the parish so they may be able to share that information with others. I also ask them to inform me of things which they hear which I may not hear. We also spend about 15 minutes at each meeting sharing insights into the following Sunday's Gospel.

In a May 2021 letter, I invited parishioners to nominate fellow parishioners to serve on the Council. There were three vacancies. I am happy to inform you that 3 people have very generously agreed to serve three year terms on the Council. Bob and Kathie Schuck as well as Dakota Roman. Bob and Kathie have been involved in the parish for many years. Bob has served on the Parish Finance Commission for approximately 5-6 years. They have helped facilitate the coffee and donuts after the Sunday 9 A M Mass. They both have shared reflections at the Seven Last Words Service on Good Friday. Dakota and his bride of two years, Sara, joined the parish within the past year. Dakota who is an Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist brings Communion to a few shut-in's. He recently graduated from nursing school and has begun a new job at Jefferson Hospital.

Bob, Kathie and Dakota join Gene Poligrates, Bill and Maureen Castro, Agnes Amora, Veronica Adamcik, Beverly Buella as well as staff members Kim Barroso, and Jacob Marquart, O.F.S.

We had the first meeting of the 2021-22 Council on Wednesday, July 28th (the last Wednesday of the month). A number of suggestions surfaced for helping to respond to the present pastoral needs of the parish: having gatherings of parishioners who live in the same Condo/Apartment buildings; Working in concert with two local Protestant pastors in welcoming parishioners from Condo/Apartment buildings; encourage participation in the Advent and Lenten program the parish will be making available; to stay connected with parishioners by making periodic phone calls to them; staffing booths at various events in the city so that more people will become familiar with our parish; developing a greater presence on social media.

As you can see it was a very fruitful meeting. Stay tune on what may develop in these areas.

I am very grateful to the veteran Council members and especially at this time to Bob, Kathie and Dakota for their willingness to serve on the Council and truly serve the parish by sharing their time, insights and counsel.
