

### A word from Fr. Bill...

### Dear Parishioners:

It is with great joy that in your name I welcome Archbishop Pérez to St. Augustine Parish this weekend. It is truly an honor that "Our Chief Shepherd" leads us in our Eucharistic celebration on Sunday for the Summer Sinulog.

As you very well know, the Sinulog is one of our parish highlights each year. It is a time we especially reflect on "Santo Niño," the Child Jesus. Since St. Augustine Parish is the National Shrine of Santo Niño, it is right and just that we celebrate the Sinulog with great festivities.

It is especially appropriate that this year our celebration, which is always the third Sunday of August, falls on August 15th, the feast of the Assumption of Mary. Why do I say this is appropriate this year? This is the year Pope Francis has designated the "Year of St. Joseph" and it was Mary and Joseph who primarily shaped Jesus' religious beliefs, practices, attitudes, values and faith. As we reflect on the child Jesus, we cannot help reflect on the incredible influence Mary and Joseph had on him as he was growing up.

I always like to take this opportunity to thank the Filipino Community for who they are and for what they do for our parish. When they came to St. Augustine Parish in 1992, the parish was struggling a great deal as the number of registered parishioners was extremely low, 121 registered households and 255 registered parishioners. It is reported the parish was about to close. Now there are 740 registered households and approximately 1400 registered parishioners. It is important to remember that many people who come to our parish are not registered. When Fr. Walt Quinn, OSA welcomed the Filipino Community, it gave new life to the parish. This is also significant because the first Catholic Church in the Philippines which opened in 1565 was served by the Augustinian Friars. The bond continues.

Archbishop Perez was scheduled to be with us last year for this great celebration. Because of the Corona Virus, the celebration as we usually know it, had to be postponed. We are very fortunate that the Archbishop is able to be with us this year.

Welcome, Archbishop Perez and welcome to all our guests who are joining us for this wonderful celebration.

Thank you, Santo Niño. Thank you, Child Jesus, for all you have been for us as a parish community.
