

A word from Fr. Bill...

"Viva Santo Niño! Viva! Pit Señor!"

Dear Parishioners:

It is with great joy that in your name I welcome Fr. Rob Hagan, OSA to St. Augustine Parish this Sunday. It is truly an honor that our newly elected Augustinian Provincial is present to lead us in our Eucharistic celebration for the Summer Sinulog Festival. Fr. Rob is not a stranger to us. He has been here a number of times for weddings and baptisms, but this is the first time he has been with us as Provincial.

As you very well know, the Sinulog is one of our parish highlights each year. It is a time we especially reflect on "Santo Niño", the Child Jesus who I talked about in my letter last weekend. Since St. Augustine Parish is the National Shrine of Santo Niño, it is right and just that we celebrate the Sinulog with great festivities.

I always like to take this opportunity to thank the Filipino Community for who they are and for what they do for our parish. When they came to St. Augustine Parish in 1992, right after a hurricane that caused a great deal of destruction, the parish was struggling tremendously as the number of registered parishioners was extremely low, 121 registered households and 255 registered parishioners. It is reported the parish was about to close. Now there are 762 registered households and approximately 1420 registered parishioners. It is important to remember that many people who come to our parish are not registered. This is a parish of choice, not geographic boundaries for many who worship with us. When Fr. Walt Quinn, OSA welcomed the Filipino Community, it gave new life to the parish. This is also significant because the first Catholic Church in the Philippines which opened in 1565 was served by the Augustinian Friars. The bond continues.

Thank you to sooo many people who contributed to our celebration this weekend: the presider for the Triduum Masses on Thursday and Friday, our outstanding choir and their director-Kim Barasso, those who coordinated and those who contributed to the journal, those who facilitated the food and the environment for refreshments, those who coordinated the parking, those involved in the liturgy (the offertory procession, Master of Ceremonies, altar servers, lectors, translators, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, ushers, etc.), those who coordinated the 50/50 raffle, those who so beautifully decorated the church and the image of Santo Niño, those who will carry the image in the procession, those who set up for the reception and those who will clean up after the last hoagie is eaten. It truly takes a village—a parish community—many, many people to bring all this together. Most of all thanks to our God and to our Filipino parishioners for being such a model for all of us of a faith filled worshipping community.

Once again, welcome Father Rob and thank you for being with us as well as welcome and a thank you to all our guests who are joining us for this wonderful celebration.

Thank you, Santo Niño. Thank you, Child Jesus, for all you have been for us as a parish community.
