### A word from Fr. Bill...

#### Dear Parishioners:

I would like to thank all the members of our 2 parish choirs for the wonderful concert they provided for us last Friday, December 10th. The length was appropriate, a little over an hour, and the tone was reflective and prayerful. The theme of the concert was "A Weary World Rejoices."

It is so appropriate that this took place just two days before Gaudete Sunday. Gaudete means "rejoice." Gaudete Sunday gets its name from Zephaniah telling the people of Jerusalem in the midst of their hardships to rejoice and have hope because God will not abandon them. St. Paul tells the people to whom he is writing, the Philippians, to rejoice in the midst of their difficulties. He tells them to let go of anxiety because the Lord is near.

At the end of the concert I told the 40 plus members of our choirs that they were modern day prophets. Just like Zephaniah and St. Paul, they were bringing joy to a weary world. We are all dealing with the hardships of the pandemic, shootings, tornadoes, etc. We need some light in the midst of darkness and our choirs brought that to us last Friday. They were giving the message that a weary world can find reason to rejoice. The reason being we are going to celebrate the great gift that God gave us, Jesus, so that we can live forever. They reminded us that in the midst of weariness and darkness there can be joy and light. The choirs provided a tremendous service to us as a parish.

We are very blessed as a parish to have, not only the talented musical parishioners we have, but ones with such generosity to volunteer many hours in rehearsals and who share their talents and selflessness with us, not just in singing but taking care of details like providing the printed program.

There are no words with which I can describe how grateful we are to Kim Barroso, our parish Music Director. Kim has been with the parish for 16 years. Our parish is noted for the superb music at our liturgies. This could not happen without the incredible expertise in music which Kim brings to us.

On behalf of all of us, I express our sincerest gratitude to Kim and our choirs to help a weary world rejoice.

I am not going to say have a wonderful Christmas on Saturday, but I do hope and pray all of you have a wonderful celebration of Jesus's birth.


