A word from Fr. Bill....

Dear Parishioners:

This weekend the Church throughout the entire world celebrates "Consecrated Life."

This is an opportunity to celebrate and give thanks for those who have consecrated their lives to Religious Life, living the vows of poverty, chastity and obedience. This includes many of the priests, brothers, and sisters who taught us in grammar school, high school and college, as well as those who have served us in the missions and hospitals, orphanages, prisons and other social agencies. As we thank God for these men and women, we might think of doing three other things. Perhaps we could make it a point to thank someone personally in Religious Life who has had a positive effect on our lives. Secondly, we can pray that more women and men will respond to God's call to Religious Life. Thirdly, we might ask a young woman or man to consider Religious Life as a vocation. I mentioned this to a young man two weeks ago. He sent me an email the next day to say I was the first person who ever asked him to seriously consider it and told me he would consider it and pray about it. I invite everyone to do the same at the appropriate time and with the appropriate people.

I would like to share with you excerpts from a letter from Archbishop Chaput's concerning "Consecrated Life."

Consecrated men and women in the Church manifest with their various ministries and charisms the Lord's mercy by faithfully carrying out these spiritual and corporal works of mercy in all they do. Every day, as they care for the needy, comfort the sick, instruct and direct souls looking for guidance, and uplift and inspire so many, these consecrated men and women make real the image of the merciful Lord Jesus. Pope John Paul II recognized the sacrifices and selfless dedication of consecrated men and women living out their special vocation. Hence, it was all together fitting that he instituted in 1977 a special commemoration of consecrated persons to be observed as a World Day for Consecrated Life.

In our own Archdiocese of Philadelphia, we rejoice in the ministries which have benefitted all of us. Consecrated men and women have provided vivid witness and personal care for so many in education, health care, social concerns and spiritual growth throughout the entire history of our local church. Likewise, our contemplative communities by lives of intense spirituality have inspired and guided so many. As all of these consecrated persons have given their lives, they have done so expecting no recompense.

Rendering thanks to God for the graces given to our Church through the selfless dedication of these consecrated men and women, we reflect upon and ask the intercession of our special patrons, Saint John Neumann and Saint Katharine Drexel. May their vision and prayers continue to sustain us as we commemorate the World Day for Consecrated Life, February 4th and 5th.

Lastly, as we have been mentioning for the past several weeks, next Saturday, February 11th we have the Day of Reflection for married couples. See details on the enclosed flyer and on our website.
