A word from Fr. Bill....

Dear Parishioners:

Periodically, the Archbishop or his representative visits each parish in the Archbishop or his representative is to meet with parishioners and staff to get a pulse of the parish. At this time, he also examines all the official Sacramental Registers of the parish. The last Canonical Visitation to St. Augustine Parish was November 2011. Monsignor Dan Kutys, Vicar General of the Archdiocese (Vice President) and Vicar of Region III (in which we reside) will visit Saint Augustine Parish for the official visitation next Saturday, February 25th. Monsignor Kutys will meet individually with the Augustinian community, the Parish Pastoral Council, the Parish Finance Commission, and each parish staff person. He will preside at the 5:15 PM Vigil Mass next Saturday. All parishioners are invited, encouraged, and welcome to participate at this Mass next Saturday evening.

As you know, a group of parishioners met for a number of weeks last summer to reflect and discuss Pope Francis' Exhortation, The Joy of Love. As a result, this group asked what we could do as a parish community to strengthen family life. They decided to sponsor a Day of Reflection for married couples. This day took place last Saturday. 
It's not a coincidence that this Day of Reflection took place on Valentine's weekend. It has been a well-kept secret that St. Valentine's Day is named for a Catholic Bishop, Bishop Valentine, who lived in the third century. In order that there could be more single men available for the army, Emperor Claudius II banned all marriages in Rome. Bishop Valentine strongly disagreed with the government infringing on religious liberty. Consequently, he disobeyed Claudius' order and married couples in secret. As a result, he was arrested, beaten and beheaded. Since then he has been associated with love and dying so others could love. I doubt if many people thought about this as they gave flowers and candy to their "Valentine" last Tuesday.

What does it mean to be someone's Valentine? It means to unconditionally love another. It means to be willing to lay down one's life for another out of love.


