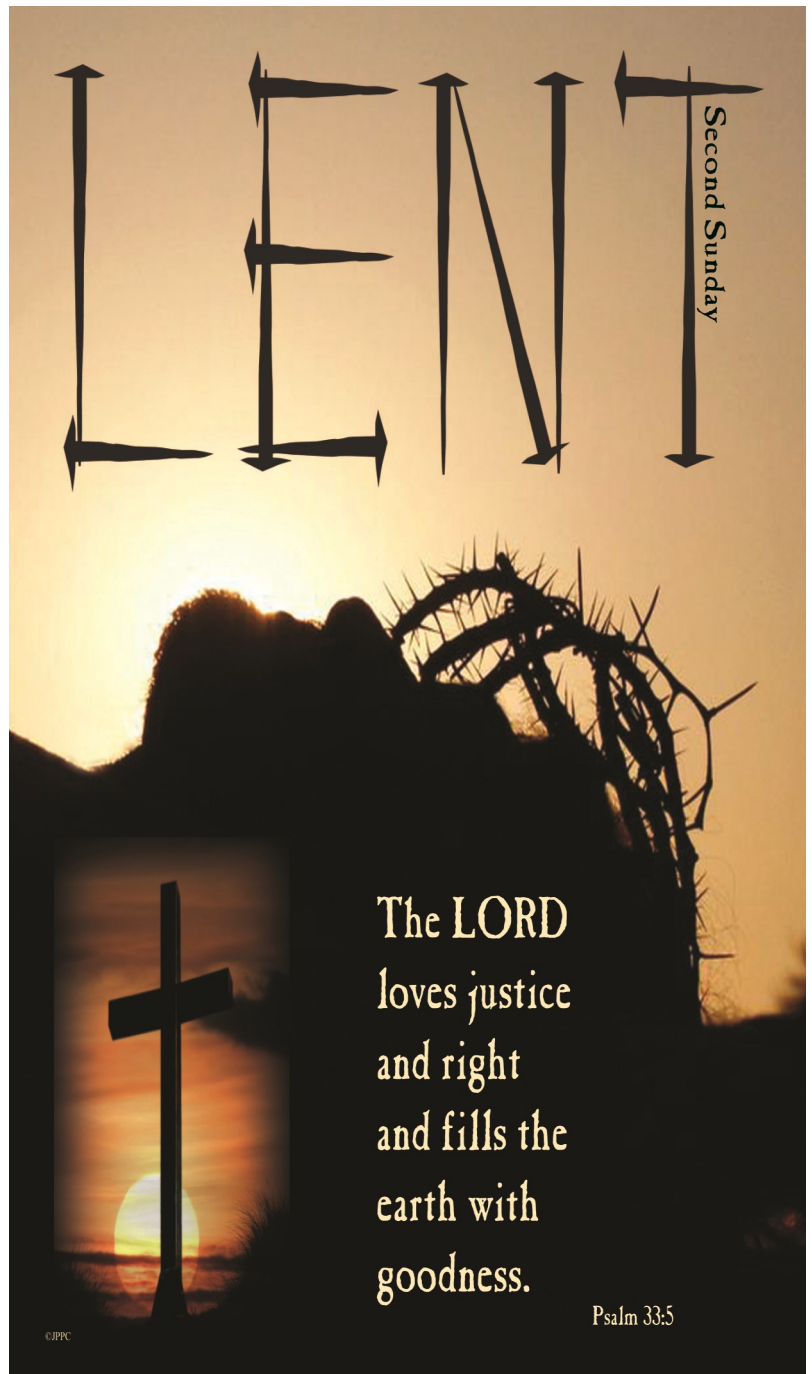

**Man Up Philly ♦ March 3, 2018**

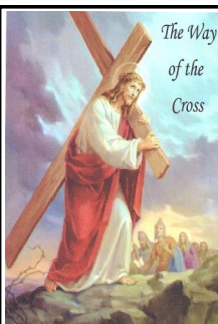

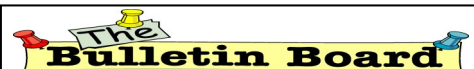

## *A word from Fr. Bill.....*

Dear Parishioners:

As you know, Saint Augustine Parish has launched our Capital Campaign, and we are very encouraged because close to \$140,000 has already been pledged by a number of our parishioners (about 18% of our \$750,000 goal).

Our next stage is to prepare to solicit directly from other parishioners, which means that we need a number of our parishioners to be willing to visit fellow parishioners. Partners for Sacred Places, the professional resource agency guiding us on the campaign, facilitates a workshop to guide parishioners for this service to the parish. We had a session in December that was very well received, and a number of parishioners have already agreed to serve as solicitors for our campaign, but we need more. We will have a second preparation session for additional solicitors on Wednesday, March 7th from 6:30 PM to approximately 8:30 PM.

By coming to this preparation session, you are not making a commitment and can make the choice after the session to be a solicitor or not. I would truly appreciate it if you would be willing to participate in the March 7th session. It is vital that this campaign be successful so that we can continue to maintain and update the facilities and the beautiful artwork which we have inherited from those who have gone before us. In order for it to be successful, we need to have as many parishioners as possible to take an active role in this campaign.
