



# A word from Fr. Bill....

# Dear Parishioners:

As you know, Saint Augustine Parish has launched our Capital Campaign, and we are very encouraged because close to \$140,000 has already been pledged by a number of our parishioners (about 18% of our \$750,000 goal).

Our next stage is to prepare to solicit directly from other parishioners, which means that we need a number of our parishioners to be willing to visit fellow parishioners. Partners for Sacred Places, the professional resource agency guiding us on the campaign, facilitates a workshop to guide parishioners for this service to the parish. We had a session in December that was very well received, and a number of parishioners have already agreed to serve as solicitors for our campaign, but we need more. We will have a second preparation session for additional solicitors on Wednesday, March 7th from 6:30 PM to approximately 8:30 PM.

In order for it to be successful, we need to have as many parishioners as possible to take an active role in this campaign.
