

A word from Fr. Bill...

Dear Parishioners:

Two weeks ago, in the gospel we heard Jesus calling the apostles to follow him. They left their nets, livelihood and family and responded to his invitation. In last Sunday's Gospel, Jesus took his followers aside by themselves and told them with the means is to heaven (like a GPS): poor in spirit, peacemakers, seeking righteousness, handling persecution.

In the Gospel this weekend, Jesus continues to give them instructions on what it means to follow him. He uses the metaphors of salt, and light. He is telling them that they have to be salt and light for others.

The significance of salt for everyday living is essential. It's valuable for preserving, seasoning and purifying food. That was true in Jesus' time and it is true in ours.

We all know the importance of light. I mentioned to you my letter last weekend that we were without light in the parish property several times in the last month. That reminds us how essential it is. Just recently, I had to get a head light replaced in the car I drive. Not to have that light is dangerous.

If you and I are to be followers of Jesus, we too must see the image that we are called to be salt and light, not for ourselves, but for others. We can help season the faith of others. We can help preserve the faith of others. There are people that we could encounter this week who for one reason or another might be in darkness. Maybe she lost a loved one. Perhaps a person got a bad report from the doctor. Maybe he lost a job. Whatever the darkness may be, our phone call, visit, assurance of prayer may be light to lead that person from darkness.

As children, many of us learned the corporal and spiritual works mercy. We learned that we can practice them in every walk of life. These works can be as simple as sharing food with neighbors when they are suffering from illness, or death in the family; we can open our homes to sick, or elderly relatives; we can give directions to strangers who seem to be in unfamiliar situations; it could be taking time out to help a child accomplish a task.

They don't have to be extraordinary ways. Just as salt and light are very ordinary things, we as ordinary people can bring these ordinary things to ordinary situations.

In our Baptism, we began to share in Jesus' life. He said he is the light of the world. He came to bring light to a darkened world.


