

# A word from Fr. Bill...

#### Dear Parishioners:

As you know, we at St. Augustine Parish began a Capital Campaign in 2017. I thought it would be helpful to give you an update on the status of the Campaign.

Our goal for Phase One of the campaign was \$750,000. To date, we have received \$794,970.68 in pledges or 106% of our goal. We have received \$732,828.80 in cash or close to 98% of our goal. Almost 25% of this has been used for various administrative costs for the Campaign and about 73% of the cash received (\$438, 836.99) has been used for Capital Campaign projects. About 2.5% (\$14,500) has been set aside in the Preservation Account.

Some of the projects which have been funded by our campaign are: the heating conversion of a furnace, upgrades to church restrooms, new windows on Lawrence Street and 4th Street in the Community Center (Women of Hope residence), installation of LED light bulbs in the church, restoration of the Crucifixion painting in the church, replacing 2 skylights in the church, painting the outside of the church window frames, restoration of the pews and new carpeting in the church, securing the Stations of the Cross, repairs to church louvers and façade, and the assessment to repair the paintings of St. Augustine's life. We will replace louvers in the church steeple, and continue with facade repairs this spring. Also this spring, there will be other improvements made to the parish property which are not funded from the Capital Campaign: additional new windows in the Community Center and restoring the lights and fixtures to the steeple clock.

We now have moved into Phase Two of the Campaign. We are working with The Catholic Foundation of Greater Philadelphia to assist us to secure grants from various sources for our projects. We are also in the process of seeking to apply to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to create a new non-profit entity. This will enable us to apply for grants from specific sources because of the historic nature of our parish as well as our involvement with community functions. In addition, we hope to develop a strategy to utilize social media to assist us with the Campaign.

None of this could have happened without your generosity and the generosity of others.

The number of other projects which need to be addressed is endless. They include installing handicap accessible doors, repairing water damage inside the church, upgrading the fire alarm system in the church, and restoring the paintings of St. Augustine in the church, to name a few. Also there is a great deal of work needed in Carr Hall and in the friary. This is why the help of The Catholic Foundation of Greater Philadelphia and obtaining a new non-profit status is so important.

I am extremely grateful to the members of our Steering Committee who very selflessly have met every month for five years now to help me navigate this Campaign. The members are Gerry and Kathy Rigby, Rene Quinlan, Fran Richards, Melissa Huggins, and Jacob Marquart, O.F.S. I also am especially grateful to Bob Zigmund, our Director of Facilities, who works with all the vendors involved in these projects.

If anyone has experience with grant writing and would be willing to assist us in this area, please be in touch. Also, if anyone has the expertise to help us develop the use of social media to expand our Campaign, please be in touch.

I hope this has been informative and brings you up to date about the Campaign.
