A word from Fr. Bill....

Dear Parishioners:

As I mentioned in last week's bulletin, we welcome Fr. Mike Sullivan, OSA this weekend to St. Augustine Parish. Fr. Mike will be speaking at all the Masses on behalf of the Augustinian Missions in Japan, Africa and Peru. Thank you for your generosity to this important apostolate of our Province.

The staff at "Women of Hope" have sent us the following message: "Many thanks for the generous donations of gloves, scarfs and coats from your giving tree."

Next Sunday, January 21st at the 11:00 AM Mass, we will celebrate the Winter Sinulog. This is the true time that it is celebrated in the Philippines. They don't have ice and snow. That is why we also celebrate it in August because then we can go out into the streets and sing and dance. Everyone in the parish is more than welcome to join us for this wonderful and faith filled celebration next Sunday at the 11:00 AM Mass.

On Sunday evening, February 11th after the 7:00 PM Mass, we will have our third "Theology on Tap." The topic this time is, "End of Life Issues." There are many questions we all deal with. "How long do I have to leave a loved one on life support?" "What are the directives concerning feeding tubes?" "Are there times when chemotherapy and radiation can be stopped?" These and others are extremely painful questions and decisions in times of crisis. Fr Jim McCartney, OSA of the Theology department at Villanova and who is very respected in the area medical ethics, will be the keynote speaker. We also will have a nurse, Lori Bellizzi, RN and a doctor, Dr. Margaret Lafferty, MD, FAAP, both active St. Augustine Parishioners, who will speak to us concerning issues which they have encountered in this area.

On Saturday, February 10th we will have our second Day of Reflection for married couples. We will begin at 10:30 AM and end with the opportunity to renew marriage vows within the 5:15 PM Vigil Mass. It is purposely scheduled over Valentine's weekend. The day is based on Pope Francis' reflections on "Love in Marriage" and will include talks by married couples, opportunity for discussion and quality time with each other. This is a way for us to affirm and strengthen married life and in turn affirm and strengthen families. If you are interested in participating, please email me at: pastorstaugustine@gmail.com. For the next four weeks, I will share different quotes with you each week of what participants said about the experience last year. Two of those who participated said:

"We are hoping to do more activities together. We are going to do more listening and praying together."

"We are going to do more things as a couple: pray as a couple, talk as a couple, hold hands when we walk."

Please set aside the Tuesdays of Lent beginning February 20 (2/20, 2/27, 3/6. 3/13, 3/20, and 3/27) to participate in our parish Lenten program. It will be centered on the drug epidemic in our society. We plan to watch and discuss a different episode of "DOPE" (from Netflix) each of the four first Tuesdays. It has been arranged that we will have a representative of the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) and recovering addicts with us each week. The last two Tuesdays will be used to help develop a plan on what we as a parish might do to respond to this monumental problem in our society. Mark your calendars now for the Tuesdays of Lent and join us for this Lenten program.
