

## A word from Fr. Bill....

#### Dear Parishioners:

This Sunday we celebrate one of the highlights of our parish year, **The Winter Sinulog**. The timing of this celebration is extremely appropriate. We have just celebrated the birth of Jesus and with our celebration of the Sinulog we reflect on Jesus as a child, **Santo Niño.** We are told in the scriptures that Jesus grew in wisdom. This is a very important occasion for the Filipino community which gives us an opportunity to express our gratitude and appreciation to the Filipino community of St. Augustine Parish. By establishing our parish as the National Shrine of Santo Niño, we survived as a parish when we might not have survived. They continue to make us strong and we continue to be thankful for all the Filipino community has done for us and continues to do for us.

On another topic. Last Spring, a group of six of us came together to read, reflect and discuss the Pope's exhortation "The Joy of Love" in which the Pope discusses in great detail the challenges and beauty of family life. After we met about six times, the members of the group looked for a way to share the experience with others. They looked for a way to strengthen family life. They decided to sponsor a day of reflection for married couples. They recognized the many challenges couples face today and how high the divorce rate is in our country. The group then met about four times to organize this day. It was intentionally scheduled to be close to Valentine's Day. It will be Saturday, February 11th. There will be an explanation of what the Pope says in the exhortation and two married couples will reflect on their married and family lives. There will be an opportunity for couples to have some quality time with each other, and the opportunity to renew their vows at the 5:15 PM Mass. If you are married, please seriously think about participating in this day. Please tell family and friends. This is a responsibility we have to let others know what our parish has to offer them. We have invited about 100 couples who were married here in the past several years. This day is being advertised throughout the Archdiocese, in the bulletins of local parishes and communicated to the Marriage Encounter community of Philadelphia and local areas.
