



Dear Parishioners:

Being the third Sunday of January, this weekend is a very significant weekend for our parish community as we celebrate the Sinulog. As you know, this is a cultural and religious festival. It is the biggest festival in the Philippines as the celebration usually attracts 1 million people every year.

It honors Santo Niño (Child Jesus). In the Philippines, there are processions in the streets, demonstrating the faith of the Filipinos. Because of the nature of our winter weather (cold, snow, ice), we have a simplified celebration of the Sinulog in January. The full version is celebrated in August when the weather is more cooperative. As the National Shrine for Santo Niño, it is important for us to be in union with our Filipino brothers and sisters in the Philippines. Thus, the January celebration.
