





A word from Fr. Bill...

Dear Parishioners:

By now, I hope you have noticed the new walkway between Carr Hall and the church building. This is the culmination of a project which started about five years ago when repairs were made to the underground tunnel that connects Carr Hall to the church. After those repairs were made, there were complications (some legal) about completing the work. You know that for some time now, the actual door going into Carr Hall could not be used. Even though we have been using the other entrance, it is not attractive, convenient and it was not handicap accessible.

I think we are going to name this area "The Tim Babbage Alleyway." Tim designed the project. Tim was in communication with an architect, and made the arrangements with the contractor. He facilitated the approval of the Philadelphia Historic Commission and was present each of the 4 days of the actual work. He made sure it is in compliance with the American Disability Acts (ADA Compliance). As the one who oversees our finances, Tim also wrote the checks from parish funds for \$38,400. From your contributions, this money gradually had been set aside for this work. I also am grateful to Gerry Rigby who helped iron out some of the legal concerns. This was central to moving on with the project.

I truly believe that being able to gather socially as a community is essential to being a faith community. I very much missed this for several years during the height of the pandemic. It is important not to just see each other at Mass, but it adds a great deal to be able to share "fellowship" which each other. This is not new to the parish as before I came to St. Augustine Parish, coffee and donuts were available after the 9:00 AM Mass and a meal was available after the 11:00 AM Mass. We are now in a good rhythm of having socials after the 7:00 PM Mass. Of course, Carr Hall is used for other things as well. We are very happy to make it available for local community meetings. At times, outside groups rent it. For all of this, it is important that it has a good appearance and that it is handicap accessible.

We are now in the process of purchasing hand rails. This should be a reality in the near future. After that, we will begin to save money to procure a new door.

Please take a stroll down the "Tim Babbage Alleyway" and join us after Mass to mingle with each other.
