
Augustinian Volunteers are Catholic men and women between the ages of 21-29 who wish to serve God's people in partnership with the Augustinian Order and others.

A Biographical Sketch of an Augustinian Saint....... Blessed Stephen Bellesini, Priest, ◆ February 3rd

Stephen Bellesini was born of a noble family in Trent on November

25, 1774 and was professed as Augustinian on I May 31, 1794. He lived in troubled times. When the government suppressed the religious houses in his region, he dedicated himself to teaching, with the aim of giving youth a cultural and Christian education to counterbalance the materialistic influences around them. In this work, in fact, he had the respect and goodwill of the local authorities. However, when the first opportunity



came his way, he resigned as Inspector of Schools in Trent and went to live in Bologna. This decision was prompted by his conviction of the importance of community living. The authorities pleaded with him to return, but his recorded reply is "You would surely not ask me to do that, if you realized the unbreakable bonds between a religious and his God, the King of Kings. Before his altar I have solemnly promised to be faithful to those vows." Later he was to become a notable novice master and was to dedicate the closing years of his life to parish work in Genezzano, where he died on February 2, 1840.
