

### A word from Fr. Bill...

### Dear Parishioners:

On your behalf and on my own, I would like to thank some members of our parish staff for their service to the parish, specifically Adam Klukiewski, Tim Babbage and Jacob Marquart, O.F.S.

In the middle of the night last Friday/Saturday, the Parish once again lost power to our buildings, consequently we lost electricity and heat. This was due to the break of underground electrical equipment on Lawrence Street. We had a funeral on Saturday morning which was conducted without electricity or heat. All things considered, it went very smoothly.

I say "once again" because right before New Years, we lost water and electricity. This was due to a water main break at the corner of Vine and Lawrence Streets. Because of this, there was a great deal of water in the basements (about 4 to 5 feet) of two of our buildings and the loss of some parish items.

On both of these occasions, Adam, Tim and Jacob responded selflessly. They dealt with city workers, our tenants (Women Veterans Center, Vagabond Missions, and Women of Hope), a cleaning company, and insurance representatives. This past weekend Adam was here all day Saturday being a liaison to PECO. Tim was here for several hours on Sunday dealing with a worker from the company who oversees our heating system. Jacob was here Saturday night making sure the computer equipment was in order to livestream our Masses on Sunday. He often responds from home when our internet goes down, and that is often. They all were in communication by phone during all these happenings.

The Bishop never said anything to me about these issues at ordination 51 years ago. I am greatly dependent on our parish staff. I want to thank them publicly, but I also want you to be aware of how fortunate the parish is to have staff members who respond so generously to our parish needs.
