
Saints Peter and Paul Parish is hosting a High School Age Youth Retreat



A word from Fr. Bill...

Dear Parishioners:

Remember the invitation from the Gospel last weekend when Jesus said, "Come to me....?" Well, I am taking him up on that invitation. I will be on retreat from this Thursday, July 20th until the following Friday, July 28th.

I will be at the Eastern Point Retreat House (staffed by the Jesuits) in Gloucester, MA. for what is called "a silent directed retreat." There will be about 30 others on the retreat. They will be lay people, religious and priests, none of whom I know or with whom I will interact except we will be present with each other at meals and Mass. We will be virtually silent for the 10 days, including meals. I say virtually because I will meet once a day with a director who will give me specific scripture readings on which to pray and reflect that day. Then I meet with the director each day to discuss the reflections and then depending on what we talked about, he/she (I find out when I get there) gives another group of scripture readings upon which to reflect and pray on how they relate to me at this time in my life.

This is a great opportunity that many people may not be able to take, to be away for ten days. I am, as always, grateful to my Augustinian community and parish staff "for holding down the fort."

I was telling this to someone last week and the person said "weren't you just on retreat? How come again"? Yes, we had the gathering at Villanova in the beginning of June of which two days were meetings and the other two days were retreat. It was far from silent as the two retreat days were basically input from a priest and then sharing with other Augustinians.

Unless there is a major emergency, I will not be available by phone, text or email.

During these days, please pray for me that I will be open to whatever God wants to reveal to me. Be absolutely assured i will be praying for you and our parish community during these days, the pastoral, sacramental, liturgical, and administrative aspects of the parish.

Thank you, Lord, for the invitation to "rest with you" and thank you for the opportunity to be able to respond.


