



## A word from Fr. Bill....

### Dear Parishioners:

I would like to thank all those who wrote, called or emailed our State Senators concerning House Bill 1947. The bill passed (49-0), but not before some substantial revisions were made to it. It balances out the responsibility of the private and public domain. I believe there were two major changes to the final version of the bill: one it does not allow the time to sue for a victim of sex abuse on the private domain to be extended to 50 years of age. Secondly it changed the vocabulary of when the public domain could be sued from if there is "gross negligence" to just "negligence." These two changes are extremely significant. It certainly does not alter our care, concern, support for all victims. But, there seems to be more equality in the private and public domains. Thank you to all who took the opportunity to raise your voices and concerns about this extremely significant and sensitive piece of legislation.

In the beginning of June all of our registered parishioners received raffle tickets and information concerning a parish dinner cruise on the Delaware River on September 30th on The Spirit of Philadelphia to commemorate the 220th Anniversary of our parish. There are not many opportunities when our entire parish family can gather with each other. I believe it is important for us to create such opportunities. We have many members of our parish involved in many different aspects of our community life: the Parish Pastoral Council, the Parish Finance Commission, lectors, Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, Gift of Life, the choirs, sacramental preparation, the Filipino community, the young adult community, a discussion group, our parish staff, etc. It is also an opportunity for those who are parishioners but who for various reasons are not that active in the parish to socialize with all of us. This is a great time for all of us to come together and celebrate a very significant event ---the 220th Anniversary of the parish. If you plan to join us for the dinner cruise, please let us know as soon as possible in order that we can make the necessary arrangements with the cruise company. Also, please return the raffle tickets at any time. If you did not receive this packet in the mail, you can pick up a flyer about the cruise in the back of the church and raffle tickets from the Parish Office. Many thanks.

I will be on Retreat all this week (Friday, July 15 to Saturday, July 23). This is what is known as an eight day Ignatian (developed by St. Ignatius of Loyola) silent retreat. The total time (including meals) is in silence. The exception is when one talks to his or her director for about an hour each day. This discussion is centered around the thoughts and insights one gets from the scripture readings assigned by the director for that day. These are assigned on the basis of what is going on in the person's life and the discussions from each meeting with the director. Jesus often went off by Himself "to a far-away place." I am not going "to too far of a far-away place." I am going to the Jesuit Center for Spiritual Growth in Wernersville, PA, not far from Reading. In relation to this week's Gospel, I am going to be "Mary" and spend time with the Lord rather than being "Martha" very active in the kitchen. Please pray for me during this week as I continue to pray about my responsibilities here in the parish. Certainly be assured of my prayers for you and all of the parish during this week.
