Dear Parishioners:

This weekend we hear the very familiar account of Jesus visiting Martha and Mary in their home. I think this story tells us a great deal about Jesus and his relationship with others and in turn with us.

It tells us that Jesus took time to relax with friends. He goes to their house and they serve him a meal. Hopefully, we all see the necessity to spend time with friends and "to break bread" with them.

I think it teaches us how much Jesus appreciated friends spending time with him. Consequently, how much he appreciates us spending time with him. He doesn't hesitate to tell Martha that Mary chose the better part because she sat and listened to him. We also know that it was Mary who at another time anointed Jesus' feet. The perfume cost about a year's wages. Think about the vastness of that gesture. Jesus allowed Mary to show her affection for him.

This is not to say that Martha didn't have a great deal of affection for Jesus. She showed her affection by preparing the meal.
