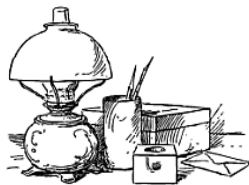

A word from Fr. Bill.....

Dear Parishioners:

In the Gospel readings for the past few weeks we have heard Jesus sending the disciples out to tell the people about "The Good News." As we hear so often, that "sending forth" continues today as you and I are called as disciples to tell others about Jesus and his message.

In that spirit, do you know someone who has never been baptized but might like to be? Do you know someone who has been baptized in another Christian religion who might like to be a member of the Catholic community? Do you know someone who has been baptized Catholic, but has not received First Communion, or maybe they have been baptized Catholic and received First Communion but have not been confirmed? Maybe just like the early Christians, they just need someone to invite them.

In the past 4 years we have had 14 people participate in our "Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)." This is a process for adults to prepare to celebrate the Sacraments of Initiation--Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. The preparation begins in September and continues until Pentecost.

If you know someone whom you think might be interested in this, please mention the possibility to the person. You may be the only means he or she would know that such an opportunity is available. We have been given much in the terms of our faith. It is our responsibility to invite others to benefit this with us.

St. Paul asked the Romans (10:14) "How can people call on him if they have not believed in him? How can they believe in him if they have not heard his message? How can they hear if no one tells them?"

Just as Jesus worked thru the early disciples to tell people about him, he may now be using you to do the same.
