

A word from Fr. Bill...

Dear Parishioners:

As I think many of you are aware, one of our Augustinians, Fr. Bill Atkinson, OSA, is a Servant of God, which means he is being considered for the cause of beatification and canonization. He was in a toboggan accident in February 2, 1965 which left him totally paralyzed from the neck down. The accident took place at our Novitiate in New Hamburgh, New York, the year before my novitiate year.

He received a telegram 50 years ago this August 1st which said, "Atkinson Dispensation Granted." This dispensation was from Pope Paul VI allowing Bill to be the first quadriplegic to be ordained a priest. Bill was ordained by Cardinal Krol on February 20, 1965 at his home parish, St. Alice in Upper Darby.

You can read a great deal more about Fr. Bill and the process for his beatification and canonization on the Augustinian Province of St. Thomas of Villanova website. You will find a specific link "Fr. Bill Atkinson, OSA."

You also will find a video about him on the homepage of our parish website. There is an excellent book, Green Bananas, by Steve McWilliams which is very inspiring.

There are plans to have a sculpture of Fr. Bill in the healing garden here at St. Augustine. I brought this to our Parish Pastoral Council last year (or the year before) for their consultation and one member responded "What a privilege that is to have it here." The sculpture will be Fr. Bill sitting in his wheelchair with a bench for someone to sit and pray/talk to him. It is planned to also have one at Bonner High School where he served for close to 30 years as a teacher, chaplain, coach, and friend to innumerable students. We are looking into having one at our Augustinian International Headquarters in Rome.

As this process continues, please pray the following prayer on a regular basis.

Prayer to Father Bill

Blessed are you, Father of Life, source of goodness and peace, in whom all creation has its origin and by whom every person is loved.

In Father Bill Atkinson your mercy and compassion were made manifest as he brought solace to the suffering and hope to the needy.

By carrying the cross of life faithfully he proclaimed confidence in your love and conformity to your will, and so drew others to you and to the generous gift of your grace.

Hear our prayers which we offer through his intercession so that as your work continues to unfold among us it may bring honor to you, comfort to your people, and, according to your will, glory to your servant. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen
