A word from Fr. Bill...

Dear Parishioners:

As you come to Mass this weekend make sure you take a good look in the sanctuary and notice how much improved some of the lighting is.

We are very fortunate that one of our parishioners, Bill Purcell, did his Eagle Scout project benefiting our parish church building. Bill is entering his senior year at St. Joe's Prep and is a member of Boy Scout Troop 78.

He began this project in September doing extensive research and has been physically in the building about 15 times. He raised about \$200 so far for about a \$900 project and he's still working on raising money.

What did he do?

There is new lighting on the top of the tabernacle, the cupola.

There is new lighting on the tabernacle itself.

There is new lighting on the candles on the back altar.

There is new lighting on the painting of the crucifixion in the center of the sanctuary

Shadows near the words "The Lord Seeth" have been removed.

There is new lighting on the two portraits in the sanctuary facing the community.

The placement of the lighting fixtures for the sanctuary is from the columns at each side, and the placement of the lighting on the two portraits is in the balcony.

What Bill has done is he has replaced incandescent lighting with LED lighting. This allows for better lighting and at the same time it is more energy efficient.

Bill said that one of the things he feels very good about with this project is that when he comes to Mass which is usually the 9 AM or 7 PM on Sundays, he will appreciate the lighting in the sanctuary. He said he has come to understand a lot more about the technology of lighting and he has been educated on new terms concerning lighting (and so have I). He was happy to use his leadership skills in having other people help him with the project and also by raising the money for the project.

We're very pleased that Bill used our church to do his Eagle Scout project. Our community has benefited a great deal. We thank Bill and we wish him well in the future.


