We have the blessed opportunity through the celebration of the Sacrament of Baptism to welcome a new member into our parish community.





# A word from Fr. Bill....

#### Dear Parishioners:

As you heard last weekend, we are accepting now nominations for the Parish Pastoral Council. The Pastoral Council is an extremely important group of parishioners as they (along with members of the Parish Finance Commission) are men and women with whom I collaborate very closely. Their role is to help me identify and respond to the pastoral needs of the parish. The Parish Finance Commission collaborates with me with all the financial aspects of the parish.

Members of the Pastoral Council meet on the last Wednesday of each month and serve in this capacity for three years. Please see the sheets in the back of the church which outline the qualifications and responsibilities of Council members. You can nominate another parishioner or yourself. If you nominate another parishioner, please include the person's contact information in order that we can ascertain if they are willing to serve. The names of all the nominees will be put in a basket and three names will be drawn from the basket at the 7:00 PM Mass on Sunday, September 10th.

Speaking about Sunday, September 10th, that evening we will have our first "Theology on Tap" after the 7:00 PM Mass. We will have four "Theology on Taps" in the next academic year: the second Sundays of September, November, February and March. On September 10th, the eve of the 16th anniversary of 9/11, we will have two speakers from the Campus Ministry Office of Villanova speak about Muslim-Christian relationships: specifically, what Muslims believe, how they perceive Jesus and Mary, and what developments have taken place in our relationship since 2001. One of the speakers, Asheq Fazlullah, is a prayer leader for the Muslim community at Villanova and the other, Julia Sheetz, directs ecumenical and interfaith outreach at Villanova. You will hear more about this as we get closer to September 10th, but you may want to put this on your calendar now.

I informed you last month of our newest source of evangelization, a Resource Center Kiosk. When I mentioned this in the June 10-11 bulletin, it was just a piece of furniture. Please take the opportunity now to browse this piece of furniture in the back of the church as it has become a flourishing Resource Center. You will find pamphlets, books, bibles, CDs, rosaries, etc., at the Resource Center. It is exciting to introduce this as it is another way to help our parishioners become more informed about and also grow in their faith. We have partnered with Stewardship: A Mission of Faith to make this possible here at St. Augustine's. This same opportunity has been available to many other churches, schools, and businesses, etc. There is no charge for the material in the display but there are suggested donations for each item, and they are just that --suggestions. The material does not cost the parish anything, nor does the parish benefit financially in any way from this. One can donate less or more than what is suggested. Your donations help to cover the cost to replenish items in the display. Items there can be beneficial to yourself in your spiritual growth, your relationships with others, and your prayer life. They also can make appropriate gifts for others on certain occasions. Please be sure to take a look and see the great variety of items which are there.
