

A word from Fr. Bill...

Dear Parishioners:

I hope everyone had a good 4th of July. Just think, Christmas is less than 6 months away.

I would like to bring to your attention two resources on our parish grounds which are available to those in need, Narcotics Anonymous and Sexaholics Anonymous.

In general, 12 step programs help people dealing with addiction to stay "clean," stay "sober." Since the 1930's, millions of people from all over the world have found a means, not to be cured, but to recover from the addiction. They have found a process to help them control their addiction, rather than the addiction controlling them.

I am very happy to say that St. Augustine Parish makes space available for three 12 step meetings a week.

Narcotics Anonymous (NA) meetings are reconvening their meetings this Saturday, July 8 at 7:00 PM in Carr Hall (basement). Those who meet are a fellowship of men and women who have struggled with the addiction of any narcotics, including addictions to prescribed narcotics. They have not met here since the beginning of the pandemic. I am extremely happy to let you know that they are gathering again in person. If anyone would like more information concerning the meetings you may contact Steve at 215-565-6217.

Sexaholics Anonymous (SA) meetings are for those who desire "to strive to stop lusting and become sexually sober," including addiction to pornography. They meet in Carr Hall (basement) on Tuesday and Thursdays at 7:00 PM. Anyone who "is having a problem with their sexual thinking or behavior" can contact SA at phillysa.org or call 267-282-0460. If you call for information, it is totally confidential.

Like all 12 step programs, NA and SA are open to men and women. There are no dues or fees as they are self-supporting through their own free will contribution. They are not allied with any sect, denomination, or politics. They do not engage in any controversies or engage, endorse or oppose any causes.

Most importantly, there is the highest priority which is anonymity. No one has to reveal his or her identity. No one is permitted to repeat anything they hear at a meeting. I am not present at any of the meetings. So, one does not need to worry about "Fr. Bill will see me." I would never know you are there, but I think very highly of you for participating in the program. I am certainly willing to be of any help to someone who seeks it and make references when desired.
