

DRUG EAWARENESS PREVENTION

Naloxone

Naloxone is used in an opioid emergency to reverse an overdose or possible overdose. It is sometimes sold under the brand names Narcan and Evzio.

Pennsylvania has passed laws making it available as a standing order which allows pharmacists in Pennsylvania to dispense naloxone without requiring an individual

prescription. Philadelphia offers trainings to administer naloxone to save those who are experiencing an overdose. The next sessions are **June 6**, **June 11**, and **June 20**. For more information, please visit the link below.

A word from Fr. Bill....

Dear Parishioners:

Please take special notice of the picture of our Parish Staff on the cover of this weekend's bulletin. This gives me the opportunity to do two things: The first is to tell you how wonderful the staff is, and the second is to explain the context of why they were gathering last Thursday.

First of all, we as a parish and I specifically are very fortunate to have the caliber of the men and women who work for the parish. I could not do any one of their jobs and I thank God every day I do not have to. As one who never changed a flat tire, I am not competent to take care of all the facilities of the property and all the ramifications involved. I am not equipped to maintain a parish office, prepare financial reports and budgets (whether accrued or not), cook (I am able to put something in the microwave), clean, or coordinate 60-70 weddings a year. As one who was told in grammar school not to sing because I looked like I had a sore throat, I am certainly not in a position to coordinate anything musical. We not only have people providing these services for the parish, but we have extremely competent, reliable, and responsible persons helping us live out our mission. By sharing their gifts, they minister to us. We, and I specifically, are extremely blessed. Thank you, Lord.

Secondly, why were they gathered when this picture was taken? The Archdiocese has a three-year program entitled, "Remain In My Love." This is an initiative of the Archdiocese to help renew Marriage and Family Life. In each of the three years there are three sessions for three different audiences. The first year was geared to all the employees at the Archdiocesan Pastoral Center. This second year is for all the staffs of parishes and schools, etc. within the Archdiocese. Next year is for married couples and families within the Archdiocese. The first session is to talk about the sacramentality of marriage (permanency, exclusiveness, imitation of Jesus's love for us, sexuality, etc.). The second session deals with "The Goods of Marriage" (unity, indissolubility, etc.) and the contemporary threats to marriage. The third session deals with the family and the domestic church including challenges in our society to the modern family, etc.

This is an endeavor of the Archdiocese for all of us to talk about an extremely important topic within the church. We all know the statistics of divorce are very high in our society. We all know there is a definite breakdown of family life today. The Archdiocese is providing an opportunity and encouraging us to talk honestly about these topics.

Our parish staff has participated now in the first two discussions. Many thanks Tim, Jean, Jacob, Bob, Kim, Agnes, and Robyn as well as Fr. Jim who joined us.
