##### ***Sacrament of Baptism***

The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on a regular basis, except during Lent. It is usually celebrated within Mass. Arrangements must be made in advance. The parents of the child to be baptized meet personally ahead of time with the priest celebrating the sacrament. Contact the parish office for further information.

Please call the parish office for information. Forms are also available in the back of the Church.

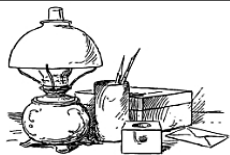
##### ***Parish Committees***

Dear Parishioners:

As you know our parish is celebrating its **220th Anniversary** this year. For several months now we have had reminders in the bulletin to "save the dates."

This past week our 600 registered families received an "Anniversary Packet" in the mail explaining our anniversary activities. For those who did not receive this mailing, we would like to keep you informed.

Next Sunday, June 12th at 3:00 PM, we will have our **concert**. This will be facilitated by our combined Filipino and Young Adult choirs. Please plan to come and invite your family and friends.

As was announced several months ago, in conjunction with The Year of Mercy, a number of our parishioners are planning to be part of a **pilgrimage to Paris as well as to Rome** where we will go through *The Door of Mercy* in September. You will find information about this in brochures in the back of the church. If you are interested in more details, please contact me.

Within this bulletin you will find a flyer with information about a parish **dinner dance and cruise** onboard *The Spirit of Philadelphia* on Friday, September 30th. In order to make the necessary arrangements with the cruise company, we need to have the paid reservations ASAP. The reason for this is if we only have 185 guests, that means we make arrangements for one of the decks. If it appears we can have 300 guests, we will make arrangements for a different deck. Obviously, we hope we will have 300 guests but there is no way of knowing that until guests pay (\$85) for their reservations. We need to inform the cruise company which deck we want as soon as possible. So, we would appreciate your paid reservations ASAP. Please ask your relatives and friends if they would like to join us.

Lastly, **raffle tickets** (\$5.00 each and six for \$25.00 with prizes of \$520, \$220, and \$120--winner need not be present to win) are in the Anniversary Packet, if you did not get the packet or if you would like more tickets, please contact the parish office.
