A word from Fr. Bill.....

Dear Parishioners:

About 175 Augustinians from the entire United States will be gathering at Villanova this week for a convocation. We will begin on Sunday evening and end on Friday afternoon.

There are three Augustinian "Provinces" in our country. We are obviously the Eastern Province (Province of St. Thomas of Villanova). We in our Province have the opportunity to gather every year with each other. But this year, the Augustinians from the mid-west (Our Mother of Good Counsel Province) and California (St. Joseph Province) will be joining us. We only have had one other convocation of all three Provinces in the past and that was in 2010 in Chicago.

Although over the years we have heard the names of different friars, many of us do not know our brother friars from the other Provinces. So, this a great opportunity to put faces and names together. It is also an opportunity for us to reflect together on our common life sharing the challenges of "the real vs, the ideal." It is an opportunity to pursue how our Provinces might collaborate better with each other, sharing our restlessness, our resources and our personnel. It is an opportunity for us to pray, celebrate the Eucharist and socialize with each other. One evening we will be celebrating significant anniversaries of our friars (e.g. Fr. Paul's 50 years of priesthood).

For the last seven years an organization entitled FANA (Federation of the Augustinians of North America) has evolved. This week's convocation gives all of us the opportunity to be in the same room at the same time to review where we have been with FANA where we presently are, and where we might want to go together in the future. It could be very exciting.

Our Prior General, Fr. Alejandro Moral Antón, OSA and our Vicar General, Fr. Joe Farrell, OSA will be present.

May we not forget that it all began right here at St. Augustine Parish with the arrival of Fr. Matthew Carr, OSA and the founding of our parish in 1796.

Because a number of our friars from the other two Provinces have never been to St. Augustine Parish, about 45 of them will be visiting us on Wednesday afternoon for about a half hour. We will give them a quick history of the parish and tell them how wonderful you are.

Please keep us in prayer during this week. Please pray that the Holy Spirit will guide our discussions and direct us in ways which are best for our communal life as well as for our service to the Church.
