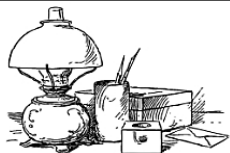

A word from Fr. Bill.....

Dear Parishioners:

This week Frs. Tony, Paul, and I will be participating with the members of our Province in what is called a "Mid-Chapter." Let me put in context what a "Mid-Chapter" is.

Every four years the Augustinians elect a Provincial and have a "Chapter." A "Chapter" is a meeting of all the solemnly professed members of our Province. At a "Chapter" we discuss and collectively decide on our way of living as a Province for the next four years. This "way of living" involves our community life and our ministerial life to the Church.

Midway between "Chapters," two years after a "Chapter," we have a "Mid-Chapter." At this gathering the members of the Province (Augustinians from the entire East Coast and missionaries from Peru and Japan) meet to assess how well we have lived out the decisions which were made at the last "Chapter."

This will be a very important week for us as for the past two years we have been involved with "planning"---- specifically how can we best serve the Church with our limited numbers, aging membership (except me) and being faithful to our first apostolate, living our community life. Much of our week will be centered on this topic and all the ramifications which are involved.

Because of this meeting, I will not be here this week. We have a visiting priest, Fr. John Tumosa, who will be celebrating the Sunday 7:00 PM Mass and each of the 12:05 PM weekday Masses.

Please keep us in prayer during this week. It is a very important time for us in our Province.
