

A word from Fr. Bill....

Dear Parishioners:

As was mentioned in the bulletin last weekend, we are very happy this weekend to welcome Brother Damien Lunders, SVD of the Divine Word Missionaries. Brother will be speaking to us about and asking for our support for their community's missionary work, especially in Thailand. As we know from the scripture readings from Jesus's "Last Discourse," which we heard proclaimed before Pentecost, Jesus told us "to go to all nations" to spread the good news of the Gospel. We cannot all physically go to Thailand or other foreign countries, but we do have the responsibility to support those who do. Obviously, the missionary work cannot be self-supportive. As Augustinians we know that. Fr. Tony spends many weekends doing exactly what Brother Damien is doing the weekend, but for the support of the Augustinian foreign missions. Please be as generous as you can for this important work of the Church.

As we celebrate Father's Day this weekend, we would like to salute all of our fathers, grandfathers, stepfathers, adopted fathers and Godfathers for their very important contribution to our lives and to our society. You will find envelopes in the back of the church on which you can enroll fathers in the nine Masses which will be celebrated for the Father's Day Novena.

You will notice in the back of the church, a new piece of furniture. It looks like a book rack because it is. But, it is a very unique book rack. It is called a "Kiosk." It is a unique system to display Catholic resources: books, pamphlets and CDs. There will be suggested donations which one can give for an item, but they are suggestions. If you cannot afford to pay for an item within the rack, please feel free to take the item. This is a means of the important ministry of evangelization of the Church. The parish does not profit from the sale of these books at all. Nor does the parish acquire any expenses at all for this service. All the donations are sent to "Stewardship A Mission of Faith." It is totally a service for evangelization to provide resources for education and information about our faith, especially on contemporary issues. There are some books in another rack, the pamphlet rack, in the back of the church which are donated to us and available to you for free. I am grateful to Our Lady of Ransom Parish in Philadelphia for making the Kiosk available to us and to Jacob Marquart, OFS for facilitating this whole process. We hope you find this addition to our parish helpful. If there are any topics which you would like to see among the items, please let us know.

Next weekend Brother Javier Aguilar, OSA will be speaking at all the Masses about religious and priestly vocations to the church. I am sure he will be informing us of his own vocation story and asking us to be more conscious, prayerful and involved in this vital ministry within the Church. Brother Javier is one of our students "in formation" who is doing an intern year at Merrimack College and will continue his theological studies in January at the Chicago Theological Union. It will be wonderful to have him with us.
