

### A word from Fr. Bill....

#### Dear Parishioners:

As I mentioned in the bulletin last weekend, Brother Javier Aguilar, OSA will be speaking at all the Masses this weekend. Brother Javier will be sharing with us his vocation story as an Augustinian. He will be asking all of us to reflect on God's call to each of us and in particular to reflect on God's call to religious life and priesthood, either for ourselves and/or for us to encourage others. As part of Javier's initial formation experience, he is presently spending a pastoral year at Merrimack College. He will return to his theological studies in January at the Chicago Theological Union.

At our Augustinian Convocation two weeks ago, Javier and 16 other young Friars renewed their temporary vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience for one year. This was a great sense of encouragement to all of us who were present. You will see his picture on the front page of this bulletin. He is the one with a circle around his head--maybe it is a halo.

Talking about our recent convocation, I would like to give you a short overview of what took place. There were 175 Friars present from four North American Provinces. Our Prior General and two Assistant Generals were present as well. We heard reports of how the Federation of the four North American Augustinian Provinces have collaborated in the past several years. This is especially evident in the ministries of foreign missions, secondary education and vocation and formation. A great deal of time was spent discussing the fears and hopes of further development of the Federation, continuing to expand our collaboration and perhaps even moving to one province for North America. Friars had the opportunity to look at many areas in which we could continue our collaboration (Augustinian Spirituality, Peace and Justice, Common Life, Communications, New Initiatives, Lay Spatiality, Unification of all four provinces and many other areas). We had the opportunity to say what specifically these areas could concentrate on and then we had the opportunity to suggest Friars to work on these possible commissions in the next four years. Just to be together with Friars we have not seen in many years and to meet ones we have never met but have heard of was a wonderful experience. It was a wonderful opportunity to interact with so many of our young Friars in formation. They shared a number of reflections and made many other contributions to the week. It was very encouraging to be with so many of them and to experience their insights, enthusiasm and competencies. As you know from the insert in last weekend's bulletin, 45 of the Friars visited our parish here at St. Augustine's during the convocation week. The weeklong experience was so well received that 94.7% of us voted to have another similar convocation in four years (2021) in California.

As you heard in the announcements last weekend, there recently was an article about our parish on line in the National Catholic Reporter. You can find a link to the article on the homepage of our website. Hopefully, we will have copies to insert in the bulletin next weekend. I encourage you to share this with family and friends. Jesus said "Don't put your light under a bushel basket." It is good for us to share the good things which are happening within our parish. If you would like more copies of this article to share with others, we can provide them for you.
