

### A word from Fr. Bill...

#### Dear Parishioners:

Happy Summer. It officially began last Wednesday. I hope it can be a time for some "R and R", for some rest and relaxation, as well a time to catch up with family and friends, or read that book that you have been wanting to read or visit that museum you have been wanting to "check out." Jesus would go to far off places to be alone. In the midst of his busyness, he would take time to visit friends, e.g. Martha, Mary and Lazarus. We all need to be refreshed. Happy Summer.

In my homily last weekend, I talked about how God can use us in spite of our limitations. We know he used Moses with his speech impediments. We hear this weekend from Jeremiah who pleaded not to be a spokesperson for God because "I am too young." Jesus used Paul whose background check would show he murdered people who believed in him. If they had done a background check on the chosen 12 apostles, they probably would have not "made the grade" in our human criteria. It was in that context that I read the following imaginary letter that Jesus may have received if he did a background check on them. Several people asked me for a copy of it. One person said at the social after the 7 PM Mass how good it made her feel, knowing the weaknesses of the apostles and yet how Jesus accepted them and gave them major responsibilities.

It was suggested that more people may enjoy it and find it helpful. It is in that spirit that I share it with you this week. I am not its original author. The letter Jesus would have received if he did a background check on the apostles is the following:

#### Dear Sir:

Thank you for submitting the resumes of the twelve men you have picked for managerial positions in your new organization. All of them have now taken our battery of tests; and we have not only run the results through our computer, but also arranged personal interviews for each of them with our psychologist and vocational aptitude consultant.

The profiles of all tests are included, and you will want to study each of them carefully.

As part of our service, we make some general comments for your guidance, much as an auditor will include some general statements. This is given as a result of staff consultation, and comes without any additional fee.

It is the staff opinion that most of your nominees are lacking in background, education and vocational aptitude for the type of enterprise you are undertaking. They do not have the team concept. We would recommend that you continue your search for persons of experience in managerial ability and proven capability.
