





A word from Fr. Bill...

Dear Parishioners:

It is that time of the year again. We are asking for three (3) parishioners to serve on the Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) for three year terms.

The PPC is one of the three Councils in the parish on which I am dependent in my role as Pastor. It advises me on the pastoral needs of the parish as opposed to the financial and administrative needs of the parish about which the Parish Finance Commission advises me. The Steering Committee advises me on the Capital Campaign and now the development of the St. Augustine Foundation.

This past year the PPC was very instrumental in helping to gather information from the survey in which parishioners participated the previous year. As a result of that information, they advised me on the development of a 3-5 year Pastoral Plan for the parish. The next Council will be instrumental in helping to implement that plan.

We meet once a month, usually the last Wednesday of the month. This past year we met in person. The meetings are about 1 1/2 hours long. Typically, there are 9 parishioners on the Council as well as three staff members. Generally, 3 members leave the board each year and 3 new ones join us. We try to have good representation of the various members of the parish, especially representatives of the Filipino community.

At the beginning of each meeting, we share insights into the Gospel for the following Sunday and share some information on what we did in the previous month in the area of evangelization. In addition to discussing the pastoral needs of the parish, at each meeting I give updates on other aspects of the parish and at the end of each meeting I ask the members what do they hear that I do not hear.


This Sunday, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity. It is the feast of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit forming the one perfect community by fulfilling perfectly their individual roles. So, as a parish community, we all have different roles which we can use to help build up our parish community. Last week, we talked about all of us have different gifts to make the Body of Christ one. One of your gifts may be to serve the parish on the PPC and help perfect our parish community. If you are interested, please be in touch with me.

I am happy to inform you that on Manna Sunday, two weeks ago, we received 50 grocery bags for the poor. This past week, these bags were delivered to The Padre Pio Prayer Center in Frankford. They distribute them to the needy in that area. Jesus said, "When I was hungry, you gave me something to eat." The apostles asked when did they see him hungry and gave him something to eat. He responded, "When you fed the least of my people." Thank you to all those who took the time to shop and paid the cost to provide these 50 grocery bags for those who are in need of food.
