

## A word from Fr. Bill.....

#### Dear Parishioners:

We are about to enter into a week very appropriately named, "Holy." It is appropriately named "Holy Week" because within this one week we commemorate and celebrate the very basic mysteries of our faith, the gift of the priesthood, the model of service, the gift of the Eucharist, the suffering, death and Resurrection of Jesus.

We begin with Passion Sunday recalling Jesus' entry into Jerusalem, knowing what he would be facing but out of love for us, he did not back away. In his words, "This is why I came."

All of our Holy Week liturgies will be celebrated as usual with two exceptions: because of COVID19 there will not be the "Washing of Feet" on Holy Thursday or the opportunity to kiss the Cross on Good Friday. We will still be able to venerate the Cross on Good Friday by either bowing or genuflecting before it, just not being able to kiss the Cross.

We will have one liturgy aide for what is known as "The Triduum." Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil signifying that it is really one liturgy celebrated in three parts over the three days. The basic mystery of our faith is God's love for us. We celebrate different aspects of that love at different times, but there is one mystery.

All of our liturgies will be LiveStreamed. If you are not able to be with us physically, please be with us virtually. Because of the generosity of many people (\$15,000), we have the equipment to be able to do this.

Our Holy Thursday and Easter Vigil, liturgies will be at 7:30 PM. Good Friday will be at 3:00 PM.

On Good Friday evening at 7:30 PM, we will have a prayer service recalling the "Seven Last Words" of Jesus. Within this service, eight of our parishioners will share their reflections on each of the "Words" and how they identify from their own life experiences with what Jesus said and with what Jesus was feeling. There also will be an opportunity for petitions and some reflective silence. It is not often we have the opportunity to hear fellow parishioners share their faith, but this a great opportunity to do just that. This will not be done in person as all the other Holy Week liturgies are. It will be done on Zoom. The magic number is 559 049 7986, password 7139. In the first reading last Sunday, we heard God telling the Israelites: "I am your God and you are my people." This is the week that in a very real way this love is manifested so clearly. Please commemorate and celebrate this most "Holy Week" with us.


