Dear Parishioners:

In the Gospel this weekend Jesus says the sheep hear the voice of the shepherd, they recognize his voice and they follow him. Jesus tells us that He is the Good Shepherd.

In a homily in 2006, Pope Francis said, "The sheep know the voice of their shepherd and recognize who he is. They know who the shepherd is, and they know who he is not. They know who is a mercenary. They know who, when the wolf comes, is going to defend them and who is going to take off."
