A word from Fr. Bill...

Dear Parishioners:

Happy Mother's Day to all of our mothers: our blood mothers, our grandmothers, our Godmothers, our adopted and foster mothers, and to all those who have been mother figures to us.

We all have our unique gifts and make our unique contributions to our blood family as well as to God's family. Mothers have their unique gifts as well. They are the first ones who fed us, probably held us, and took care of our basic needs. They are the first ones who probably taught us to pray, to share and to care. They became models for us.

There is no such thing as a perfect parent, as there is no such thing as a perfect person, but our parents (both mother and father) were obviously our first mentors, our first models, our first cheerleaders, those who first loved us and accepted us as we were, helpless. Their impact on one person can have effects for generations.

Today, we thank God for our mothers and all the women in our lives who have had that maternal influence on us.

My own mother died when I was young, 9 years old, but there were many other women who had a mother's influence on me for whom I am grateful. My mother would be 122 years old today and I give thanks to God for the influence she had on me and my 5 older siblings many years ago, influences of which I am probably not totally aware but that still affect my life, my personality and my vocation today.

As a mother, Mary had a tremendous unique influence on Jesus. She watched him grow up, take on an identity, become an adult seeking to do God's will, watched him suffer and die. She never wavered from the role God had for her.

Today, we thank those who have had that same role in our lives. We pray that we may honor them always with a spirit of profound respect.
