Snow Removal → Second Collection

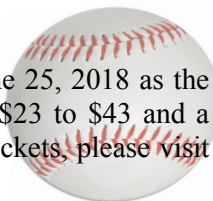

A word from Fr. Bill.....

Dear Parishioners:

Happy Mother's Day to all mothers, grandmothers, mothers-in-law, Godmothers, stepmothers, foster mothers, adopted mothers, expectant mothers and everyone (single or married) who is a mother figure to another. We all need nurturing in our lives. Although both male and female are responsible to nurture others, this weekend we especially honor our mothers and all those who have nurtured us. I understand nurturing as giving care and attention so that someone (or something as a plant) can grow and develop.

From the beginning of time God had been the epitome of nurturing. It is clear in Genesis that God is the source of all creation. Isaiah (49:15) reminds us that God is the perfect example of compassionate nursing when he asks if a woman can ever forget her nursing child, and then states that even if she did, God will never forget us. Isaiah (66:13) also reminds us that as a mother comforts her child, God will comfort us.

Thank you to all those women who have reflected God to us by nursing us to grow, and by showing us compassion and care. In a special way (in particular in our novena of Masses) we give thanks to God and honor you this weekend.

In a special way Catholic Social Services of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia wants to reach out to mothers (and fathers) who are thinking about making an adoption plan for their unborn child. They will help expectant parents who are considering this possibility to explore options that are in the best interest of all involved. As we have been announcing, one of the outcomes of our Lenten program concerning drug awareness and education is that our 4th and last Theology on Tap for this year (academic year) will be a panel discussion concerning drugs after the 7:00 PM Mass next Sunday, May 20th. The panel will consist of two agents from the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) and two recovering addicts. There will certainly be time for questions and discussion. Adult beverages will be provided.

As an FYI concerning our follow up on our Lenten Drug Awareness and Education program, we thought you might be interested in knowing that 42,676 pounds of prescription drugs were collected across Pennsylvania and Delaware by the DEA and its partners during the Prescription Drug TakeBack event on April 28th.
