

A word from Fr. Bill.....

Dear Parishioners:

At the 7:00 PM Mass next Sunday, Pentecost Sunday, Ignacio (AKA Junior) Romanowski, will receive First Communion and be Confirmed. We would like to encourage as many as possible to participate in this wonderful parish celebration.

Junior who is close to 60 years old is not a stranger to our parish community. He first came to St. Augustine Parish 42 years ago, but very consistently he has been coming here for the past 15 years. Those who usually participate in the 5:15 PM Saturday Vigil Mass, will recognize him because he takes up the collection at that Mass each week. He has participated faithfully in the process of our Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) since September.

Junior, son of a Polish father and Puerto Rican mother, is one of seven children who grew up in the Northern Liberties section of Philadelphia. He went to Thomas Jefferson Elementary School and Benjamin Franklin High School. For the past 15 years he has worked in the mailroom at the Philadelphia Housing Authority.

Junior responded to an announcement at Mass last summer informing parishioners of a process for anyone who would like to receive the Sacraments of Initiation. When asked why he wanted to do this he said, "I feel this is the right step, going in the right direction to fulfill my faith. This is not only a benefit to me but also to my family and fellow parishioners. I want to help in any way possible."

Junior is right on target. It is a benefit to all of us. It is a witness of someone who wants to grow in the faith; a witness of someone who is willing to spend a great deal of time to learn more about the faith and a witness of someone who is very willing to publicly profess that faith.

It is very appropriate that we will celebrate this great occasion on Pentecost, the day Jesus gave us the gift of the Holy Spirit in order that His Church would continue. And we celebrate next Sunday that it will continue thru Junior. Thank you, Junior, for reminding us of all of that. Thank you for your witness. Please be assured of our prayers as you continue your faith journey.

I encourage all who are able to participate in the Pentecost liturgy next Sunday at 7:00 PM as Junior receives First Communion and is Confirmed.
