A word from Fr. Bill....

#### Dear Parishioners:

We had a wonderful celebration at the 7:00 PM Mass last Sunday night with the affiliation of one of our parishioners, George Munyan, to the Augustinian community. This affiliation which took place because of George's "distinguished cooperation for the good of the Order," aligns him now as an Augustinian, sharing "in all the spiritual benefits of the Order." You will notice on the front page of this bulletin a picture of George after he received his certificate of affiliation with the Prior General of the Augustinians throughout the world, Father Alejandro Moral Antón, OSA, the Vicar General of the Augustinians throughout the world, Father Joe Farrell, OSA, and the Prior Provincial of the Augustinians of the Province of St. Thomas of Villanova, Father Michael Di Gregorio, OSA. It truly was an honor to have all three of them with us for this great occasion.

As I mentioned in the bulletin last weekend, several of our parishioners will be speaking at the Masses this weekend: Ed Riehl (5:15 pm), Jacob Marquart, OFS (9:00 am), Toni Mesina (11:00 am), and Greg and Lily Walsh (7:00 pm). They have been participating weekly since September in a scripture discussion group called RENEW which I described last weekend. They have agreed to lead 4 discussion groups during Advent, beginning the week of November 26th. Parishioners can choose to be part of a group on Tuesday evenings at 7 PM facilitated by Jacob, or on Wednesdays at 7 PM facilitated by Greg and Lily, or on Thursdays at 7 PM facilitated by Toni, or on Saturdays at 11:00 AM facilitated by Ed. Initially, all the groups will meet here at the parish. Once the groups come together they can make specific decisions as to time and place. You will have an opportunity after the Masses this weekend and the next several weekends to sign up to participate in one of these four groups. The following are comments by those who have been participating in RENEW since September:

"I enjoyed having reminders of my faith, doing action, and I appreciated hearing the Gospel on Sunday after our discussion."

"It helped me apply the Gospel reading during the week."

"I enjoyed being in a group sharing as well as listening to other people share their insights into the Gospel. It strengthened my faith. It gave a different perspective of the Gospel."

"It feels like a mini retreat in the middle of the week."

"The Gospel has been more alive because I experienced it deeper."

"For me, it is a different way to pray."

In the midst of the hectic schedules preparing for Christmas, please consider to take the time to participate in one of the four RENEW groups in the parish for the four weeks of Advent.

As a reminder, we will have our second Theology on Tap after the 7:00 PM Mass next Sunday, November 12th. The topic will be "Exorcism and Spiritual Warfare." Our speaker will be Monsignor Ralph Chieffo, Pastor of St Mary Madeline Parish in Media. Monsignor is considered an expert in this area as he has had a great deal of experience with this topic in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. He will be speaking about demons, jealousy, pride, gifts of the Holy Spirit, possession, expulsion of demons, etc. There will be adult beverages and munchies. A free will offering is always appreciated. Please plan to attend.
