A word from Fr. Bíll...

Dear Parishioners:

Each year we try to give you, our parishioners, an update on the financial status of the parish. In that vein, Tim Babbage, our parish accountant and business manager, will present an overview of the parish finances at our three Masses this Sunday. Tim also will have a graphic in the pews of the specifics of the income and the expenses. In addition, you will find this on our parish website (www.st-augustinechurch.com) under "Information" then "E-giving and Finances" along with previous annual reports beginning in 2014.

We are always very grateful for your generosity, but in particular during the pandemic. Each week in the bulletin you will find a report of the previous week's offertory collection. It always amazes me that the average amount in each envelope and in each electronic giving is in the vicinity of \$35. We also are grateful for your generosity of giving \$20,000 to the 225th Anniversary Appeal. This money, as explained in the beginning of the appeal, is set aside in a Preservation Account for a horrific emergency. Hopefully, it will never have to be spent.

Because of your generosity, especially to the Capital Campaign, we were able to accomplish the following Capital Improvements this fiscal year:

- $\Rightarrow$  St. Augustine Parish Center (Women of Hope) windows \$24,000
- $\Rightarrow$  Equipment for LiveStreaming \$15,000
- $\Rightarrow$  Exterior painting of church windows \$16,400
- $\Rightarrow$  Brick pointing of church building \$50,000
- $\Rightarrow$  Carpet for church \$16,000
- $\Rightarrow$  Refinish Center Aisle Pews in the church \$50,000
- $\Rightarrow$  Refinish Side Aisle Pews in the church \$30,000 (received a specific donation for this)
- $\Rightarrow$  Tunnel repair expenses \$1,763 (Part of \$75,000 multi-year approved capital project will be finished this year we hope)
- $\Rightarrow$  Assessment to repair the portraits of St. Augustine in the church \$9,600

For your information, our Capital Campaign has moved into Phase 2. Our goal for Phase 1 was \$750,000. We have over \$794,000 pledged (over \$105 % of the goal) and we have received in cash over \$730,000 (just over 97% of the goal). Some pledges are still coming in. So, hopefully we will meet the original goal in cash received.


Our Steering Committee for the Capital Campaign has been very busy developing Phase 2 of the campaign. We have contracted with the Catholic Foundation of Philadelphia to help us identify specific foundations to whom we can apply for grants for specific projects. The other aspect of Phase 2 of the campaign is preparing non-profit by-laws and articles of incorporation in order to receive a separate 501(c)(3) status which would increase our eligibility for some grants. We have received a great deal of legal counsel for this.

It may sound trite, but none of this would be possible without the generosity of many people: the financial generosity of you, our parishioners, sharing your treasures to the weekly offertory collection, the Capital Campaign and the 225th Anniversary Appeal; the generosity of our parishioners on the Parish Finance Commission and Steering Committee generously sharing their time advising me at our monthly meetings on all these matters; the generosity of our staff in sharing their talents to implement all these administrative aspects of the parish. I am blessed to be surrounded by so many generous people.

I am grateful for Tim's presentation at the Masses this weekend. I hope between his presentation, his hand-out found in the pews and this letter, that you have a good understanding of the financial status of the parish.


