

A word from Fr. Bill...

Dear Parishioners:

Tim Babbage, our accountant here at St. Augustine Parish, will be speaking at the Masses this Sunday communicating the "State of the Finances" of the parish.

We have a responsibility to make you aware of the financial situation of the parish. "It is truly right and just" to do so. This is your parish. It is your generosity that allows us to function. Your generosity is published each weekend in the bulletin. For example, the following is the report which was in last weekend's bulletin.....

Sacrificial Giving: October 23, 2022

Number of Envelopes Used: 18 Amount in Envelopes: \$1,035.00 Average \$/Envelope: \$57.50

Electronic Giving: 42

Amount Electronic: \$1,315.00 Average \$/Electronic: \$31.31 Loose Money: \$567.00

Total Collection: \$2,917.00

Each weekend differs as some parishioners make their donation once a month. That will affect the average each week. We are happy to report that the number is increasing for those who contribute electronically. Please note that about 80% of our weekly collection is from those who use envelopes or electronic giving. If you do not use either, please consider doing so. You will find information on how to do so on our parish website or call the parish office. I encourage you to review this financial report each week in the bulletin.

Tim will give a report this weekend on the income and expenses for the fiscal year July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022. You also will find a sheet with an overview in the pews. This gives a summary of the Operating Income and the Operating Expenses with a graph that explains by percent the source of the income and the area of expenses. Please note that 37% of our total income is from the Offertory Collection. Consequently, you see how dependent we are for the operation of the parish on weddings and rent which is 56% of our total income. You can find this report for the past seven years, beginning in 2014, on our parish website (go to Information and then Giving and Finances). You will notice in these reports that each year we basically have a balanced budget with not a great deal of excess revenue.

Overall, our financial situation is good. We are up to date with our bills, including our assessment to the Archdiocese. There is some money in reserve for capital improvements and as I explained in my letter a few weeks ago we are hopeful to receive grants from 5 different resources to which we applied. If we receive these grants, among other things, we will be able to respond to needs such as repairs to the tower of the church, having an automatic handicap door for the church, providing a sprinkler system in Carr Hall and the Women of Hope residence, updating the kitchen in Carr Hall, and providing handicap access to Carr Hall.

It is Church law (Canon 537) that "Each parish is to have a finance council......to aid the pastor in the administration of parish goods......." I am extremely grateful to Jerry Lorenz, Rosemary Lorenz, Ruth Luyun, Ferdi Luyun, Gerry Rigby, Tim Babbage and Brother Jacob who faithfully meet with me once a month to advise me on the financial and administrative aspects of the parish. They provide an invaluable service to the parish. Quite frankly, they give me a sense of security in dealing with these areas. Otherwise, I would be overwhelmed and feel incompetent in this aspect of my responsibility as pastor. The Bishop did not talk about any of this at ordination.




