serious health issues and are either awaiting or have received transplants. It has been a truly wonderful experience for all the Parish volunteers involved. Each time we cook and serve, we receive very heartfelt thanks from so many people. We've been told that, after a day of medical appointments, therapies or other demanding activities, it is gratifying to sit down and relax with a tasty meal made by people who obviously care!

Our two volunteer crews from the church prepare dinner onsite in Gift of Life's huge, modern kitchen, on the third Tuesday and fourth Sunday of each month. We have a good variety of menu options, some of the favorites being rotisserie chicken, barbeque, Italian dishes, roasted potatoes, and lots of fresh veggies. We continue to experiment and add to the recipe collection. Over the past year we estimate that we have served meals to more than 1,000 people!!



## A word from Fr. Bill....

Dear Parishioners:

Good stewardship is not just supporting the parish financially, as important as that is, but also supporting the parish with my time and talents.

St. Peter said in a letter to the early Christian community, "Each one should use whatever gift he or she received to serve others, faithfully administering God's grace in its various forms." (1 Peter 4:10)

Hopefully, you have noticed that there has been a great deal of improvements made around the propriety in the last several months: paving of the parking lot, stripping and waxing of the church floor, cleaning of the church carpet under the pews, painting a number of outside doors around the property, etc., but there is a great deal more that needs to be done.

Can you paint? We can use help with painting some fences, 1st floor windows around Carr Hall and the Friary. Can you clean? We can use help cleaning a storage room near the steeple (inside), stripping and cleaning the stairs leading to the choir loft. Do you have a background in plumbing, carpentry, masonry or electrical areas? There are many different projects around the property which need to be addressed. Obviously, anyone in these areas would have to have the proper qualifications. Volunteer work in the maintenance area of the parish could be done on weekdays or with special arrangements on Saturdays. Can you count? Can you stuff? Do you have any computer skills? We could also use volunteer help in the office. We could have one, two or three teams to count the weekend collection on Monday mornings. We could use help periodically with parish mailings and other varied office needs as they arise.
