

# A word from Fr. Bill....

#### Dear Parishioners:.

As I announced in the July 12th bulletin, we will have our first "Theology on Tap" on Sunday, September 10th after the 7:00 PM Mass. We plan four "Theology on Taps" this coming academic year: September 10th, November 12th, February 11th, and April 8th, the second Sundays of those four months. On September 10th, the eve of the 16th anniversary of 9/11, we will have two members from the Campus Ministry team at Villanova speaking about Muslim -Christian relations: specifically, what do Muslims believe, how do they perceive Jesus and Mary, and what developments have taken place in our relationship since 2001. One of the speakers, Asheq Fazlullah, is a prayer leader for the Muslim community at Villanova and the second speaker, Julia Sheetz, directs ecumenical and interfaith outreach at Villanova. Everyone in the parish is invited. Adult refreshments (beer and wine) will be provided with some "munchies." There will be an opportunity (of course) for a free will offering. Obviously, this topic was chosen to begin our four-part series this year because it is the eve of 9-11. Please feel free to invite your family and friends. If it is convenient, join us first at the 7:00 PM Mass. "Theology on Tap" will begin at approximately 8:15 PM.

We all have been devastated by the destruction of Hurricane Harvey in Texas. Some people have lost their lives. Some have lost loved ones. Some have lost their homes. Some have lost their businesses. Some have lost valuable possessions. It will take a great deal of time and work for life to get back to normal, if it ever will for some. Are you or anyone you know in need of healing because of dealing with guilt, depression, and/or anxiety as a result of an abortion? There is a retreat entitled, "Healing after Abortion" on October 6, 7 and 8 in the Malvern-Frazer area of PA. It is designed to help you experience the mercy and compassion of God. It helps you focus on the buried emotions of the past and begin healing in a non-judgmental, safe, loving and confidential environment. It helps to give hope for the future and freedom from the pain one may be experiencing. Concerning the retreat, one woman said, "I received great healing during my retreat. I recommend it to anyone suffering from abortion. I was able to forgive myself and found Christ's unconditional love." One man said, "For 18 years, I have been haunted by guilt that no one could take away. Through the retreat, I was able to forgive myself.
