
If you live in an Old City condo, please consider joining the Condo Outreach Ministry. The Parish

A word from Fr. Bill...

Dear Parishioners:

As you may remember, in 2017 we had 8 parishioners who reflected on Pope Francis' encyclical entitled "Laudato Si" (On Care for Our Common Home). As a result of those discussions, we asked parishioners during that Lent to be educated more about the topic and to take steps to help care for our environment. Thus, St. Augustine Environment Committee came into existence. This committee developed a questionnaire for parishioners asking in what areas would they be willing to be involved during Lent to help for "The Care of Our Common Home." This questionnaire consisted of very specific suggestions in the areas of Sustainability, Energy Conversation, Energy Efficiency, Management of Natural Resources, Safeguarding Drinking Water, and Lenten Observances. After Lent, we had another questionnaire (of course) asking parishioners in what areas they were involved before Lent and in what areas they became involved during Lent. 96 parishioners responded to the second questionnaire. There were a number of parishioners said they would do were: switch to more renewable sources of energy, use efficient light bulbs and appliances, install high efficiency faucet aerators and shower heads, do a home energy audit, use less water, have one additional meatless day a week, join an environmental group, use reusable shopping bags and refillable water bottles, and be aware of the material used in furniture and flooring), etc.

Like many things, as time went on and for various reasons, after making some great contributions this committee ceased to exist.

I mention all of this for two reasons:

One is to remind ourselves of some of the very practical things in which we can be involved for the care of our common home, and perhaps recommit ourselves to one or more of them or maybe to begin to respond to some of those aforementioned issues.

The second reason is to see if there are any parishioners who would be interested in recreating an Environment Stewardship Committee for our parish. If you would, please let me know.
