



A word from Fr. Bíll...

Dear Parishioners:

First of all, Happy Mother's Day to all of our mothers, grandmothers, stepmothers, adopted mothers, and Godmothers. This is a day set aside to thank you for allowing God to use you in various roles as instruments to reflect to us God's love, concern and protection. One of the ways we can experience God is through you. Enjoy the day which is dedicated to thank you.

I would like to bring to your attention a new page on our parish website. It is entitled: "Preservation **Donations.**" http://www.st-augustinechurch.com

Please go to our parish website and you will find the link on the right side at the top of the homepage. Sometimes, parishioners or visitors will ask if there are any projects to which they could donate. I always answer "yes." Needs often arise which are not budgeted. I mentioned in my letter a few weeks ago that in order to have the fire escape at the Women of Hope building pass inspection, we needed to have \$14,000 worth of repairs done. This wasn't budgeted, but certainly a necessary project. One of our generous parishioners read about this and sent a \$1,500.00 check to help with the expense. If you go to the website page, you will see the need for other projects. E.G.... We have signed a contract for \$257,000 worth of repairs (brick and stone pointing, brick replacement, wood repair, etc.) for the church tower. We have \$190,000 in donations for the project, but we may have to take close to \$70,000 from our Preservation Account and operating account to pay for the project and we would rather not drain all of our resources. We would like to upgrade the microphone/sound system for the church/choir (\$17,000), upgrade the lighting on the St. Augustine paintings in the church (\$5,000), produce more "My Faith Journey" videos (\$4,500 each) and professionally clean and wax the church floor (\$2,000). If you would like to help with any of these projects, please visit the new page on our parish website and it will direct you automatically to make an online donation.

At the 11:00 AM Mass next Sunday, Pentecost Sunday, Bryan Sobchuk will be confirmed and receive the Eucharist for the first time. Please keep Bryan in prayer as he is fully initiated into the Church. More about this wonderful occasion next week.

For safety, please don't include any glass bottles.






