

A word from Fr. Bill...

Dear Parishioners:

This Thursday, we will celebrate Ascension Thursday. With this feast, we recall that the ministry of Jesus on earth was completed and he commissioned the apostles to continue it, "Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature."

Wow, "to the whole world......and to every creature?" What a tall order. Here we are 2000 years later and commissioned to do the same.

Many times people will say that their faith is private and that they are not comfortable discussing it with others. Jesus said: "proclaim it."

We are not asked to stand on street corners and proclaim the Gospel, but we are asked not to keep it to ourselves. We are asked (it is more like we are told by Jesus) to find some ordinary ways in ordinary circumstances.

Here are a few suggestions:

- 1) BRING A PARISH BULLETIN TO SOMEONE who does not ordinarily receive it.
- 2) INVITE SOMEONE TO MASS.
- 3) INVITE SOMEONE TO A PARISH EVENT
- 4) DISTRIBUTE FLYERS OF UPCOMING PARISH EVENTS.
- 5) TELL SOMEONE ABOUT A GOOD CHURCH EXPERIENCE, LIKE A HOMILY OR CONFESSION.
- 6) TELL SOMEONE YOU WILL PRAY FOR THEM OR INVITE THEM TO PRAY WITH YOU.
- 7) IF AWAY ON A WEEKEND WITH FAMILY OR FRIENDS MAKE IT A POINT TO GET TO MASS.
- 8) WEAR A RELIGIOUS SYMBOL, PIN OR CROSS, AND SEE THE CONVERSATION THAT CAN take place.
- 9) INFORM SOMEONE WHO HAS MOVED INTO MY CONDO /APARTMENT/NEIGHBORHOOD ABOUT MY PARISH.
- 10) SAY GOD BLESS YOU WHEN SOMEONE SNEEZES
- 11) Tell someone who had a bad EXPERIENCE WITH THE CHURCH TO COME AND TALK WITH SOMEONE WHO MAY BE ABLE TO HELP THEM.
- 12) CELEBRATE THE ANNIVERSARIES OF BAPTISM OF CHILDREN, GRANDCHILDREN AND GODCHILDREN.

Every month each member of our Parish Pastoral Council commits to doing one of the above in the next month and then reports back the following month on how it went.

Would you be willing to take this list, place it on your refrigerator (or elsewhere) and commit to doing one of these things each month?

If we all did this, maybe some progress would be made to "proclaiming the Gospel to every creature."

Hopefully, as we celebrate Ascension Thursday, we take seriously Jesus' words to proclaim the Gospel to every creature.

For safety, please don't include any glass bottles.




